

OCBC COMMODORE'S CUP

Commodore Cup Fleet Participation Requirements

1. The 2011 Commodore's Cup competition shall be contested in a match racing format. The Class of Boats has yet to be determined.

2. Each fleet must determine its champion in a competition consisting of Sailing a minimum of nine races. Races to be drawn from shall include Tuesday nights, Wednesday nights and all Regattas from June through August. A qualifying Race shall be a race having a minimum of 3 boats of the same fleet SAILED AND SCORED in an OCBC sponsored event. Non-OCBC boats of the same fleet may count to make up the 3 boat minimum. However only the scores of OCBC members shall be counted toward the championship as related to the Commodores Cup.

3. Fleets must notify the Commodore's Cup Committee in writing (preferable in electronic format) no later than May 29, 2011 as to their Fleet Rules and schedule of races to determine their fleet champion. The Committee shall promptly review those submittals and inform each fleet of any deficiency in their proposal.

4. Each fleet champion must be Skipper of Record and sail as helmsman for at least 7 of the races in which he or she is scored.

5. Each Fleet shall submit the name of its champion and a scoring summary to the Commodore's Committee by September 1, 2011.

6. Entrees of Fleets submitted after May 30th will be subject to Commodore's Cup Committee approval. If there are any questions please contact one of the Committee members and we will try to answer your questions as quickly as possible.
