**1. Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the current *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, 2009-2012.

**2. Eligibility**

The skipper must be a member of CSSA. \$10 Dues can be paid at registration.

**3. Registration**

**3.1** Registration will be in the OCBC clubhouse 10/xx from 1700 – 2000 and 10/xx from 0800 -1000. Pre-registration is not available. For planning purposes (trophies, meals, etc.) please email [faydan1@msn.com](mailto:faydan1@msn.com) if you are planning on attending with boat class and crew number.

**3.2** The entry fee for this regatta is \$22.00 per boat including skipper. \$5.00 for each crew. Fee includes continental breakfast on Sat. and Sun. morning and Beer Saturday after the races. Beef Stew dinner with all the trimmings will be served Saturday night for \$5.00. Additional tickets for dinner are available. Please provide your own lunch and on the water hydration. US Sailing members receive a \$2.00 discount on adult entry fee.

**5. Sailing Instructions**

The official Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

**6. Venue**

The regatta will be conducted on Lake Hefner in northwest Oklahoma City from the Oklahoma City Boat Club. The Oklahoma City Boat Club offers two hoists for launching as well as two ramps. There is plenty of room for trailer parking and camping is permitted on the grounds. Restrooms and

showers are available in the clubhouse. Registered boats may be left on the grounds until the 2010 Hiram Douglas Regatta at TSC.

## **7. Courses**

The courses shall be as described in the sailing instructions.

## **8. Scoring**

**8.1** Five races are scheduled.

**8.2** One completed race constitutes a series.

**8.3** Low point system: 1 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, etc. DNF = number of finishers in fleet; DNS = number of entries in fleet; DSQ = number of entries in fleet plus 1 point. Boats must have a sail number to be scored.

## **9. Trophies**

**9.1** 4 boats in a fleet = 1 trophy; 8 boats = 2 trophies; 12 boats = 3 trophies.

**9.2** Handicapping: The current Lake Hefner PHRF System will be used for keel boats and Portsmouth for centerboards and multihulls.

## **10. Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See *RRS 4, Decision to Race*. Neither the organizing authority nor the host organization will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
