#### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by current *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), 2009-2012*.

#### 2. Eligibility

The Skipper must be a member of CSSA, or another *US Sailing* regional sailing assoc. if skipper resides outside CSSA region

#### 3. Registration

**3.2** Entry fee for this regatta is \$22.00 per boat, includes skipper \$5.00 each for crew. US Sailing members receive \$2.00 Discount. Fee includes continental breakfast Sat. and Sun morning. Beer and sodas after the races

#### 5. Sailing Instructions

The official Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

#### 6. Venue

The regatta will be conducted on Lake Hefner in northwest Oklahoma City by the Oklahoma City Boat Club. OCBC offers two Hoists for launching as well as two ramps. There is plenty of room for trailer parking and camping is permitted on the grounds. Restrooms and showers are available in the club house. Many restaurants and hotels within a few blocks.

#### 7. Courses

The courses shall be described in the Sailing Instructions

#### 8. Scoring

**8.1** Five races are schedule

**8.2** One competed race constitutes a regatta

**8.3** Low point system 1 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3 for 3<sup>rd</sup> etc. DNF=number of finishers in fleet; DNS=number of entries in fleet  
DSQ=number of entries in fleet plus 1 point. Boats must have sail number to compete.

#### 9. Trophies

**9.1** 4 boats make a fleet. 3 trophies per class

**9.2** Handicapping; the current Lake Hefner PHRF System will be used for keel boats, Portsmouth for centerboards and multihull

#### 10. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See *RRS4 Decision to Race*. Neither The organizing authority Nor the host organization will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta
