

GUST



PURPOSE: Central State Sailing Association has formed an alliance with Oklahoma City Boat, Club, Ninnescah Sailing Club, and Windycrest Sailing Club to bring a full summer of sailing opportunities with high-quality professional instruction to primarily youth sailors. The contributing clubs also plan to provide similar instruction at a few adult sailing events. The purpose of this alliance is to increase participation and quality of instruction, and to produce more competitive sailors in the CSSA region.

SYNOPSIS: The focus of instruction will be on Optimists, Sunfish, Lasers, and 420s. The age limits for the youth events are 7 – 18. Youth events will include Sailing Camps, Racing Clinics, and on-the-water Regatta Support. The contributing clubs paid for the instruction and development of the GUST and the sailing programs and have authority over the events they host.

ELIGIBILITY: Individual GUST Memberships are open to all youth sailors. Adult sailing events will be open to adults as determined by the host clubs.

FEES:

- **Individual Memberships**.....\$300.00
Includes all youth events June 2 – August 13, 2006, *Children of OCBC members only pay \$150.00.*
- **Jr. Membership at NSA**\$25.00
In the event a youth sailor is not a member or a child of a member of NSA or OCBC, he/she is required to pay this fee
- **Damage Deposit**\$100.00
All youth are required to pay. If, at the end of the summer, they are not responsible for damage to club property or another sailor's property, this is refunded
- **Adult Fees** are determined by the host clubs

SCHEDULE: Member sailors will have access to all youth events throughout the season. See schedule posted at www.CSSASailing.org for dates and locations.

MEMBER CLUBS PROVIDE: Contributing Clubs, when hosting events, will provide the following:

- Housing and supervision for traveling sailors
- Support boats
- Land supplies (white board, markers, etc)
- Asst. Coach (Level 1 or Asst. Level 1 Certified preferred), if necessary, at the discretion of the hosting club
- Volunteers for support of coach and sailors

MEMBER SAILORS PROVIDE: Sailors are responsible for providing the following at each event:

- Early Registration – 2 weeks
- Bring Your Own Boat
- Lifejacket, Sailing Shoes, Swimsuit, Towel, Sunscreen
- Lunch & Drinks, if required
- Other personal items as determined by member clubs
